Paulding Fine Arts Association is a non-profit organization that has more than a 40-year history of promoting, cultivating, and nurturing the inner artist that resides in all human souls.

January – February: **Student Art Show.** Open to all Paulding County children up to 19 years of age regardless of schooling. Prizes awarded.

April – May: **Spring Art Competition.** Open to all regional artists, 18 years of age and up. Prizes awarded.

May: **Doris Butz Memorial Scholarship.** Awarded to a graduating Paulding County senior, regardless of schooling, going into higher education focused on the fine arts.

June – July: **Kids Summer Arts Camp.** Open to all regional children ages 6 – 12 years. Multiple art categories explored. PFAA provides the venue for teachers and classes.

September – October: **Fall Art Competition:** Open to all regional artists, 18 years of age and up. Prizes awarded.

There are other competitions throughout the year limited to members of the PFAA. Prizes are awarded. Please see the Membership and Sponsorship information in our pamphlet or go online to our website.

Paulding Meadows Arts and Crafts Festival. Weekend after Labor Day. We sell curly fries and root beer!

Fall Fest in Downtown Dallas. 2nd Saturday in October. We rent booth spaces, including for food trucks. 10% of the booth fees goes into the Doris Butz Memorial Scholarship. Raffle Tickets sold and monetary award presented.

A GALLERY WALK

Your path is a loop along the left-hand walls beginning at the glass entry doors to the large anteroom outside the ballroom.

Stay to the left-hand wall, viewing the artwork along the outside wall and then looping back along the opposite wall and back into the anteroom.

(do not enter the ballroom)

Follow the long wall outside the ballroom and then down the hallway into the main reception area.

Pass by the reception desk and front doors, then continue to walk along the left-hand walls, enjoying the art and using this guide to identify the artist, media, and if the piece is for sale.

You can begin your tour at any point along the Gallery Walk path. Standing in front of a painting, just flip through the pages until you find it. Begin your walk at that point, remembering to keep to the left-hand wall.




